August 20, 2024

Regular monthly board meeting was called to order by Supervisor Tim Tallman at 7:00 pm on August 20, 2024, at the Bangor Municipal Offices.

The regular Town Meeting started at 7:00 pm Supervisor Tim Tallman started meeting with Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Town Board reviewed the minutes from 07/09/2024 meeting, Councilman Robert Vandeusen made a motion to approve minutes and Councilman, Jeremy Donaldson seconded it all was in favor.

Reports were giving by:

Code Officer: Submitted a hard copy of his report and \$185.00 for permit fees to the town clerk. General Dollar-New Building, update on land foreclosures. Carbon Fuel Ban, fuel oil and gas on all new stick build homes. (electric only).

Town Justice: submitted a ck for \$3577.00 to town supervisor.

Dog Control: Kim gave her report to town board members on the grant for animal shelter. \$60.00 in donations.

Highway Superintendent: Jamie St. Hilaire gave his report on damages done to our town caused by flooding from storm Debbie, (roads, culverts wash out, driveways) is still on being assets. Lee road paving will be pushed back do to damage flooding caused till end od Sept.

Water Operator: Jamie St. Hilaire gave report to board. All good.
