Regular Meeting

April 08,2025

Regular monthly board meeting was called to order by Supervisor Tim Tallman at 7:00 pm on April 08, 2025, at the Bangor Municipal Offices.

The regular Town Meeting started with Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Town Justice issued a check in the amount of \$ 3,976.00 to the Town Supervisor.

Tax Collector: Mary Cartier gave her report and a hard copy on 2025 land taxes to each town board member and submitted a check for \$3,012.98

Dog Shelter: Kim gave her report to the town board and submitted her hard copy to the town clerk, also stated Katie Trim a foster home for animals are full, donations are coming in she also put a post to raise donations for animals. Also haven't heard anything yet on Dog Shelter grants.

Water Operator: Jamie St. Hilaire stated everything was good on water no complaints. Submitted the bids for upgrade on the water plant got 3 bids for upgrade.

Councilman Joey St. Mary made a motion seconded by Councilman Robert Vandeusen to have Rafa Systems Inc. to upgrade water plant for \$10,900.59 all board members agreed, 4aye 0 nays.

Town Highway Superintendent: Jamie St. Hilaire stated everything was good at the Highway, Dept. Jamie Thanks Tim Tallman. Salt Shed is getting done.

New Business: Colin Miller discusses with board members on the deep ditches on County Rt. 53, and the properties that are an eye sore on Depot Street, Jamie St. Hilaire said he will address ditches with the county. The code officer has sent citations to homeowners on the situation on Depot Street.

Town Supervisor: Tim Tallman discussed with Town Board and Bookkeeper Linda McElwain that they should put something in budget for cemetery maintain for 2 cemeteries in case the state steps in.
